
Trim Options



9026	Office/Privacy Latchbolt retracted by knob/lever from either side unless outside is locked by inside thumbturn. When locked, Latchbolt is retracted by key outside or knob/lever inside. Inside knob/lever always free for immediate exit. Auxiliary latch deadlocks Latchbolt when door is closed.	F26
9030	Passage Latchbolt retracted by knob/lever from either side at all times.	F01




